

## American Cranberry bush Viburnum (*Viburnum trilobum*)



Mature Height: 8-12 Feet

Mature Width: 8-12 Feet

Features: Lacecap type flower clusters (showy, sterile flowers in a ring around smaller, fertile flowers); flowers white in late spring; bright red fruit in clusters in late summer and autumn (often persisting into winter); summer foliage dark green with a maple-leaf appearance; autumn color is reddish purple.

Culture: Full sun to partial shade; moist, well-drained soil is best, but is tolerant of wet soils; also tolerant of alkaline soils.

## Arrowwood Viburnum (*Viburnum dentatum*)



Mature Height: 6-12 Feet

Mature Width: 6-12 Feet

Features: Creamy white flowers in broad, flat clusters in late spring; small, dark blue fruits in flat clusters in late summer (slightly showy); summer foliage is crisp and dark green; autumn color is red, but varies in intensity.

Culture: Full sun to partial shade; moist, well-drained soil is best, but can tolerate wet sites and some dryness as well; prefers a slightly acid soil.

## **Blackhaw Viburnum (*Viburnum prunifolium*)**



Mature Height: 12-15 Feet  
Mature Width: 8-10 Feet  
Features: Creamy white flowers in flat-topped clusters in late spring; fruits ripen from yellow green to pink and finally blue-black by mid-autumn; autumn color is deep purple red.  
Culture: Full sun to partial shade; moist, well-drained soil is best, but tolerates dryness; tolerant of alkaline soil.

## **Buttonbush (*Cephalanthus occidentalis*)**



Mature Height: 6-12 Feet  
Mature Width: 6-15 Feet  
Features: Tiny, creamy white flowers packed closely in a ball-like structure, in mid-summer; fragrant and attractive to bees; fruit also in ball-like structure, green with a red tint, turning brown late in the season.  
Culture: Full sun; must have moist soils and can grow in wet sites (even along the water's edge); tolerates alkaline soil.

## Gray Dogwood (*Cornus racemosa*)



Mature Height: 10-12 Feet  
Mature Width: 10-12 Feet  
Features: Creamy white flowers in clusters in late spring; bluish white fruit in late summer (eaten quickly by birds); bright red fruit stalks remain after fruit is gone; autumn color is purple.  
Culture: Full sun to shade; prefers a moist, well-drained soil, but tolerates wet and dry sites; tolerates alkaline soil.

## Winterberry (*Ilex verticillata*)



Mature Height: 6-9 Feet  
Mature Width: 6-9 Feet  
Features: Bright red fruit on female plants; autumn color is pale yellow.  
Culture: Full sun to partial shade; moist, well-drained soil is best, but tolerates wet sites; tolerates alkaline soil.
