

**Dyer Resident,**

Soon Republic Services will dropping off one Blue 95 Gallon Cart for trash and one Blue 95 Gallon Cart with a Green Lid for Recycle. There will also be a Blue 65 gallon cart for trash and Blue 65 gallon cart with a recycle sticker available for those who do not want the larger container. Please call our office at 219-662-8600 to get the cart exchanged for the smaller size.

Automated trucks utilize a mechanical arm, which will wrap around the trash and recycle cart that we have provided you, & empty the contents into the top of the truck. Our carts are designed to work with this collection system.

**Basic procedures:**

1. On trash day, please place your cart within 4 feet of the roadway.
2. Please be sure there is at least 3 feet of clearance between your trash cart and recycle cart and any other object, i.e. mailboxes, trees, vehicles, guide wires, etc..
3. Please do not overload your trash cart. Loose trash on top of a cart will always end up on the ground as it falls down the side of the truck while the cart is being emptied. All extra trash bagged or canned will be picked up by the driver. We just ask to get as much trash in the container as possible.
4. Place the cart at the curb with the arrows on the lid pointing to the street. Should your cart not have arrows, the wheels should be away from the street. This will prohibit damaged to your lid as well as leave your lid shut after emptying.
5. Items that are too large to fit in a trash cart (stove, couch, washer, dryer, etc.,) should be placed outside the cart with 3 feet of clearance so the truck can grab the large item.
6. Yard waste should be placed in cart with trash when possible. **NO LEAVES PLEASE!**
7. Republic makes recycling easy. No sorting, just place it loose in the Blue Cart with Green Lid or Blue 65 Cart with Recycle Sticker. Place cart in the same place as you would the recycle bin. Keep cart 3 feet from Blue Trash cart. **Recycle will be collected every other week.**

**Acceptable Recyclables:**

- A) All #1 through #7 plastics, including plastic bags
- B) Glass bottles and jars
- C) Empty aluminum, metal, tin and steel cans
- D) News papers and inserts
- E) Magazines, phonebooks, soft cover books
- F) broken down cardboard/Cereal boxes, brown paper bags
- E) Office and school papers

**Recycling will begin every other week starting on the north side of US 30 May 5th & 6th then south side of US 30 starting May 12th & 13th.**
